The California Student Aid Commission has created WebGrants 4 Students (WGS) just for you, the student. The goal is to provide you with the resources, information and tools needed to assist you with the college financial aid process. WGS will allow you to manage your Cal Grant and/or Chafee account(s) online by letting you view updates, make school changes, make address changes, make corrections, and post leave of absence requests. It is important for you to understand that your WGS account does not replace your School or FAFSA accounts. Each account must be monitored and managed independently.

- What happens if I missed the March 2nd deadline and plan on attending a Community College?
If you missed the 3/2 deadline and are attending a California Community College, you have until September 2nd to submit your Cal Grant GPA Verification Form and your FAFSA to be considered for a Community College Cal Grant Competitive award. If your school cannot submit your GPA electronically, the paper Cal Grant GPA Verification Form must be certified by the school. - PARENTAL ACCESS
Keeping in compliance with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act, if you are a student who is either 18 years or older or attending college, we are unable to assist your parent with questions pertaining to your account without your permission. For security purposes and to protect your privacy, you must complete a Third Party Release Form (G-25) on WebGrants for Students at www.webgrants4students.org, which will authorize your parent to act on your behalf.
