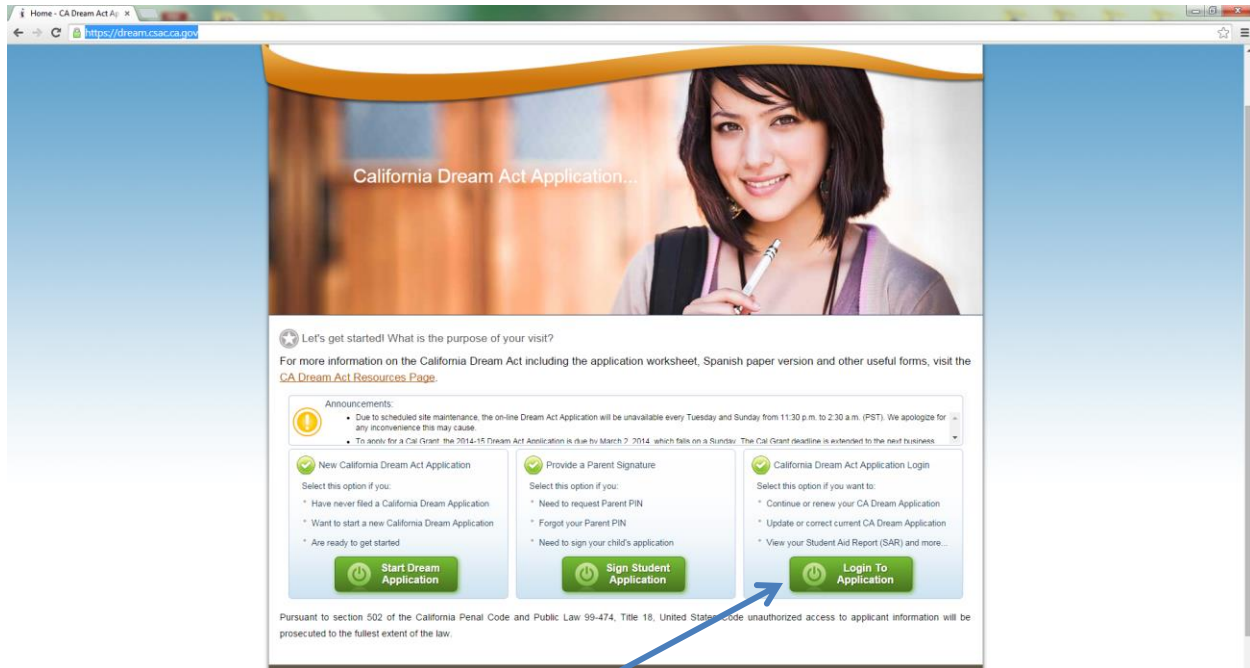


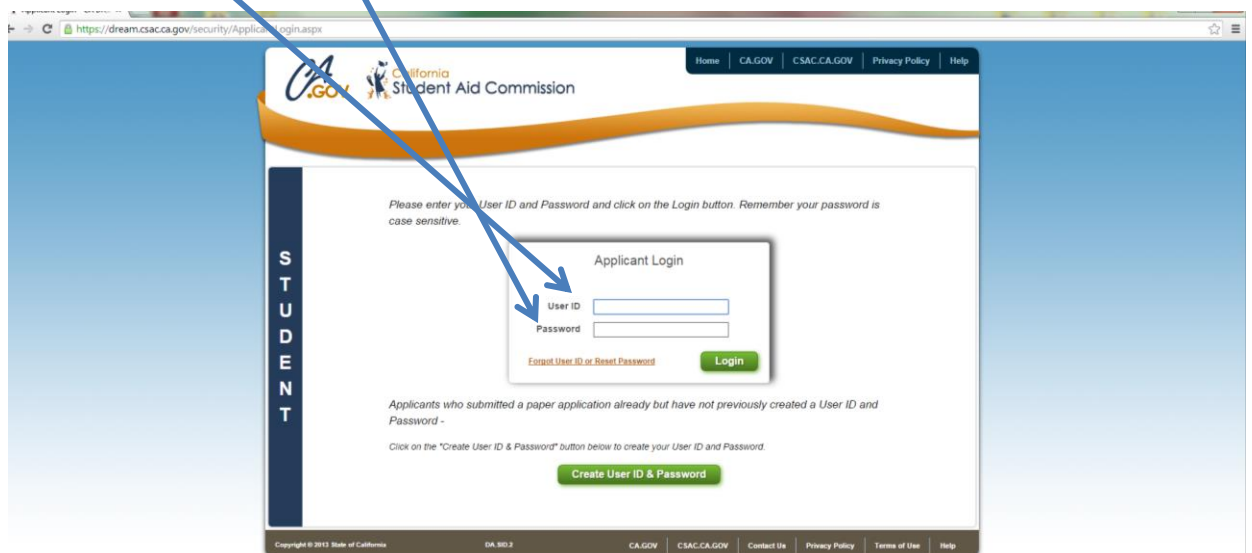
How to retrieve your Dream Act Student Aid Report (Dream SAR)

1) Go to the <https://dream.csac.ca.gov/>



2) Click on Login to your application

3) Input your USER ID and password



4) Click on the appropriate academic year

Welcome to your California Dream Act Application! Read these 8 tips first:

2. Clicking the **Save button** will add time to the running clock and give you as much time as you need to complete your application. You can also save your application and return to it another time.
3. The **red text** throughout the Dream Act Application means **"further action is required from you."**
4. Based on your answers to questions, this application may skip questions that are not required.
5. Use the tabs above or the Next & Previous buttons below to move through your application. **Do not use your web browser's Back or Forward buttons.**
6. Make sure you **submit your application** when complete. **Saving your application** is not the same as submitting your application. Only **submitted applications** can be processed for financial aid.
7. After you have hit the **submit** button, if you need to make changes, your wait time is a maximum of 24 hours to modify your submitted application.

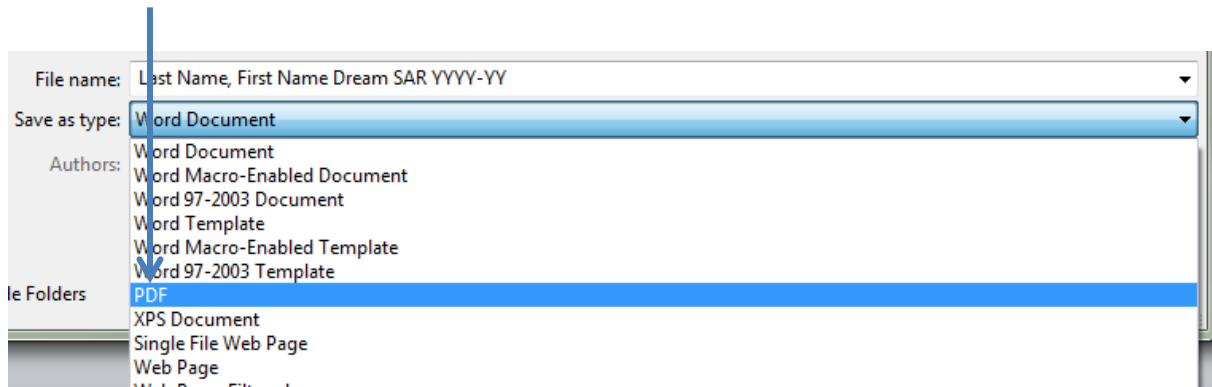
